**Terms & Conditions for Auction of Mithun**

The procedure and terms & conditions for auctioning of eight mithun are given below:

1. The details of the Mithun for auction are as under:

2. The **Public Auction** will be held at **ICAR-NRC on Mithun, Medziphema Farm on 21.08.2019 at 11:30AM.** onwards.
3. All interested parties are requested to attend the auction on the above specified place & time. The party quoting the highest rate shall be awarded the auction sale.
4. The bidder who wants to participate in public auction should registered with ID Proof and security money Rs 5000/- will be deposited to the Cashier, ICAR-NRC on Mithun, Medziphema, Nagaland through POS Swaping Machine/ online to the Institute A/C. against a token number to be issued. During the auction process, acceptance or rejection of a bid will be announced immediately on the stroke of the hammer.
5. If a bid is accepted, earnest money (25% of the bid value) will immediately be taken on the spot from the successful bidder through online transaction into the Institute Account or through the POS machine.
6. The base price mentioned in the list is minimum reserved price. Bidding below the minimum reserved value will not be accepted.
7. The bidder should check the animals for all aspects before bidding. No complaints will be entertained once the bidding formalities are over.
8. The highest bidder will have to deposit the whole amount by account transfer, RTGS, POS, Swipe machine available with the cashier on the same day of bidding failing which the Bid Security will be forfeited. UTR No./Deposit slip towards deposit of the bid amount should be submitted to the farm Incharge to obtain delivery of the Mithun(s). However, the security money will be refunded to non-successful bidders within a week.

9. **The highest bidder will have to supply self attested photocopy of his Identity proof (Aadhar/Ration Card/PAN Card/Driving Licence/Electricity Bill/Voter Card, etc.**
10. The purchaser will have to lift the animals(s) from the farm within the next three days of successful bidding. In case, he fails to do so, management and feeding cost of Rs. 100/- per day per animal will be charged. The Institute will not be held responsible for illness or death of the animals after deposit of the bid value by successful bidder.
11. The successful bidder shall have to make their own arrangement for lifting of the animals and in no case, auctioned animals will be allowed to be kept in the farm for more than 7 days failing which the Institute will be free to dispose off the animals suitably.
12. The bidder should take precautionary measures for the safety of the workers while lifting/transporting of Mithun.
13. If any bidder does not follow the instructions of the ICAR-NRC on Mithun officials or create any type of nuisance, then he can be disallowed to participate in the bidding and can be asked to leave the venue immediately or legal action will be taken against him/them as deemed fit by this office.
14. The Mithun once accepted for sale shall not be taken back or exchanged.
15. Bidder has to arrange all necessary permits for transporting the Mithun at his own cost including payment of auction fee, taxes and other charges, etc., if any as applicable.
16. The Director of the Institute reserves the right to reject or accept any, or all the bids without assigning any reason whatsoever.
